General Information

What To Bring:

Bible, Pen/Pencil, Notebook
 Pillow, Sleeping Bag or Bed Sheets
 Toiletry/Hygienic Items, Appropriate
 clothing for every worship service (See
 below.), Recreational equipment, and
 Money for snacks and other items.

Camp Rules:

- 1) Camp fee is \$100 per camper.
- 2) Campers must be at least 13 years old or be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 3) All campers (whether leadership or student) are expected to remain on the campgrounds unless permission to leave has been secured from a camp director.
- 4) Use of tobacco in any form is strictly prohibited.
- 5) Modest clothing must be worn at all times. (see guidelines below)
- 6) No Personal Electronics (such as CD or MP3 players, radios, video games, TVs, etc...). 2-way walkie talkies are useful and acceptable, but must be used on channels other than 7 and 8.
- 7) Prank activities which deface the camp are forbidden.
- 8) All campers are exhorted to follow 1 Corinthians 10:31.
- 9) All vehicles are encouraged to rest from Monday afternoon until Friday morning. Please do not disturb them by using them as shuttles around the campground.

Clothing Guidelines:

1) Hats, Caps, and Do Wraps/Rags are fine to wear any time except during any worship service.

2) Shorts are welcome attire at any activity at camp with the exception of evening worship services. Campers are encouraged to wear shorts that are at least knee length. You will need shorts for afternoon recreation which are both modest and non-restrictive.

3) All shirts/tops should be long enough that they can be tucked in or cover the belt line. All shirts/tops should have sleeves. All shirts/tops should have a neckline no lower than a typical crew-neck T-Shirt. Also, please avoid see-through fabrics.

4) Any clothing bearing wording or illustrations should be acceptable for a Christian setting. Those bearing logos or advertising for rock bands, alcoholic beverages, casinos, bars, etc. are not considered appropriate.

5) If you intend to swim, bring an item of clothing which was sold as a swimsuit. No one should see it unless they are in your cabin or at the pool with you if you are a girl. If you are a guy, bring a special shirt along to wear to and from the pool.

6) Pants and shorts should fit your unique body style properly. Please avoid shorts and pants that are either tight or baggy.

7) Evening Worship is the culminating event of the day's schedule. NC2 enjoys many visitors each night for this Spiritual activity. It is a special time which necessitates special respect in attire. Many young ladies wear skirts or dresses. You should aim to meet or exceed the standard of clean, undamaged jeans and a clean, respectful shirt. Be picky in your presentation for Worship and you will not be disappointed!
